## ABOUT THIS WORKSHOP

This workshop teaches a framework for thinking when responding to the needs and interests of people who are at risk of being devalued. It will explore social devaluation and its consequences for people who are marginalised and how SRV can be used as a means of addressing those experiences of devaluation.

Participants will be asked to consider and discuss how individuals, human services and society contribute to the marginalisation of such people.

The workshop will inspire participants to imagine the good life and consider how we may support people who have been denied so many beneficial features of a good life, to have better lives and greater involvement in their communities.
