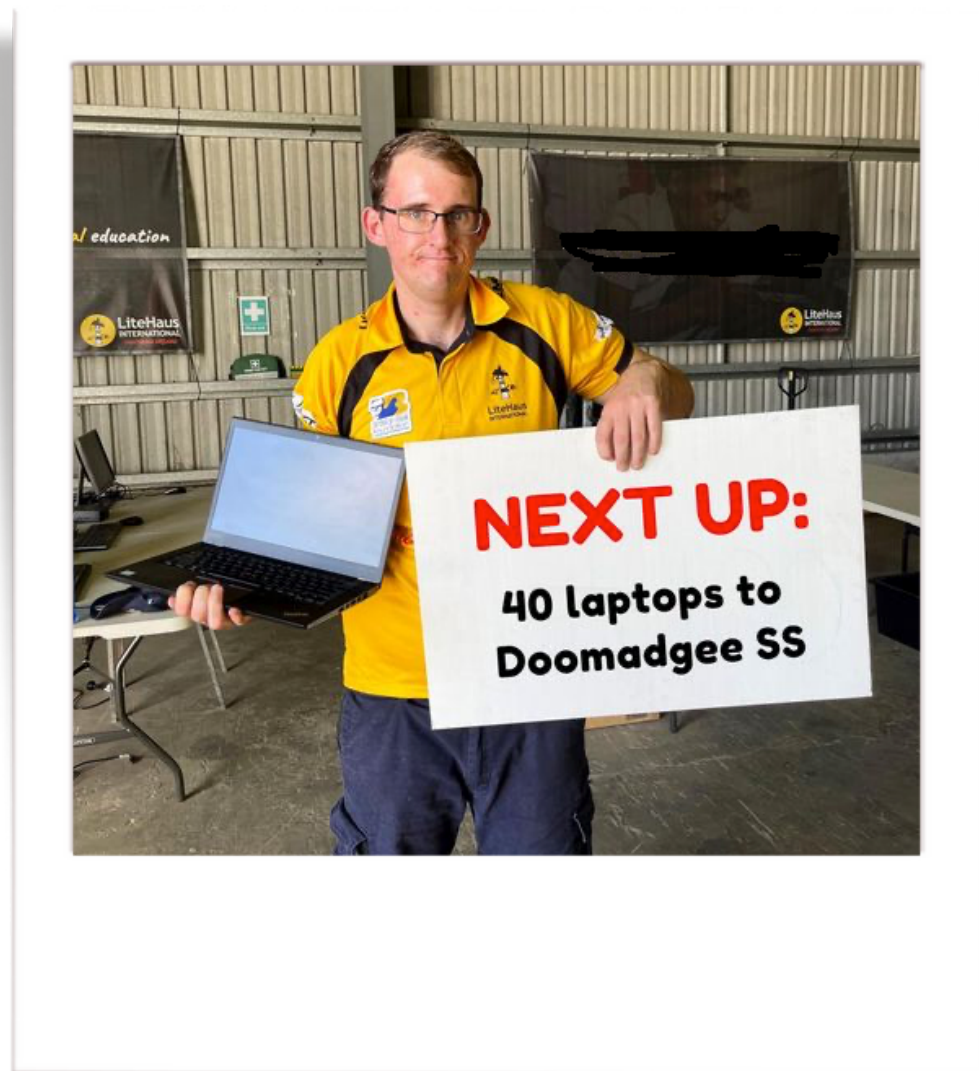

Money and Choice - May not be enough **Why & how Valued Roles can bring about the good things of life.**

However, sometimes this is not enough.

This conversation gathering will explore:

- How can we identify and build upon things we already know about a person, such as talents and interests.
- The importance of Valued Roles, and how to create Role Goals while "Thinking Typical and Ordinary"
- What to be mindful of along the way such as needs, vulnerabilities, caution of choice, negative roles and congregation/segregation.
- Identifying who might assist with bringing these role goals to life.
